

Preparation for Worship

Use the Call to Worship passage on the inside of the Order of Worship

Key points from the catechism:

- This is a **universal call to praise** - All nations and peoples are called to praise the LORD, for His glory extends to the whole earth.
- **The Reason for Praise** - God's great lovingkindness towards His people; faithful covenant love that never fails.
- **God's Everlasting Truth** - His truth endures forever, giving His people confidence and hope across generations

Suggestions for Prayer

- **Worldwide Praise** - That He would awaken in us a heart that longs to see all peoples praise His name.
- **Grateful Hearts** - Thank Him for His great lovingkindness toward us, that gratitude would shape our worship
- **Steadfast Faith** - That we would be grounded in His everlasting truth as we come before Him in praise

Confession of Sin

Congregation: O Father, we are gathered before You, the Maker of Heaven and Earth, whose chosen dwelling place is with the broken and contrite, to confess that we have sinned in thought and word and deed; we have not loved You with all our heart and soul, we have not loved You with all our mind and strength; we have not even loved our neighbor as ourselves. Purge us from selfishness, the fear of man, and the love of praise. In your mercy, deepen our sorrow for the wrong we have done and for the good we have left undone, so that we may hate our sin with a holy hatred. But, please Father, do not leave us in sorrow. With You, O Lord, there is forgiveness. In Your mercy, restore the joy of our salvation; so that we may love You with a holy love. Amen.
