Preparation for Worship

Use the Call to Worship passage on the inside of the Order of Worship

Key points from the passage::

- Praise is becoming to us** - Joyful praise is the proper and fitting response of the righteous to the LORD.
- Skillful and Joyful Worship** - God is honored when His people praise Him with glad hearts and with excellence, offering their best
- A New Song** - As those called by Him and made righteous in Christ, we sing a new song of praise for His ongoing faithfulness and works.

Suggestions for Prayer

- Joyful Praise** - That He would fill our hearts with gladness so that our praise rises joyfully to Him.
- Wholehearted Offering** - Pray that we would bring our best - skill, attention, and affection - as an offering of worship.
- Renewed Wonder** - Pray He would give us fresh gratitude for His mercies, that our praise would never become routine.

Officiant: Sing for joy in the LORD, O you righteous ones; praise is becoming to the upright.

Congregation: Give thanks to the LORD with the lyre; Sing praises to Him with a harp of ten strings.

Officiant: Sing to Him a new song;

Congregation: Play skillfully with a shout of joy.

Confession of Sin

Congregation: Lord Jesus, we have sinned times without number, and been guilty of pride and unbelief, and of neglect to seek You in our daily lives. Our sins and shortcomings present us with a list of accusations, but we thank You that they will not stand against us, for all have been laid on Christ. Deliver us from every evil habit, every interest of former sins, everything that dims the brightness of Your grace in us, everything that prevents us taking delight in You. Amen.

Assurance of Pardon Colossians 2:13-14

“When you were dead in your transgressions and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He made you alive together with Him, having forgiven us all our transgressions, having canceled out the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us, which was hostile to us; and He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.”

Confession of Faith

I believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of Heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, His only begotten Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; He descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. From there He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic* church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.
