

Preparation for Worship

Use the Call to Worship passage on the inside of the Order of Worship

Key points from the passage:

- **Praise in Every Place:** God is to be praised in His sanctuary and in all creation.
- **Praise for His Mighty Deeds:** We worship God for who His surpassing greatness and for what He has done..
- **Every Breath is for Praise:** All who have breath are called to praise the LORD; worship is the calling of all of those created in His image.

Suggestions for Prayer

- **Wholehearted Praise:** Pray that He would fill us with a desire to praise Him with all that we are.
- **Remember His Works:** Ask the Lord to help us recall His mighty deeds so our worship is full of gratitude and awe.
- **A Life of Praise:** Ask for the filling of the Spirit that every breath the Lord gives us would be used to honor and glorify His name.

PREPARATION FOR WORSHIP

Prelude: Use this time and the meditation on the back to quietly and prayerfully prepare yourself for worship

Call to Worship **Psalm 150:1-2; 6**

Officiant: *Praise the LORD! Praise God in His sanctuary; praise Him in His mighty expanse.*

Congregation: Praise Him for His mighty deeds; praise Him according to His excellent greatness.

Officiant: *Let everything that has breath praise the LORD.*

GOD CLEANSSES US WITH THE BLOOD OF CHRIST

Confession of Sin

Congregation: Have mercy on us, O God, according to Your steadfast love; according to Your abundant mercy blot out our transgressions. Wash us thoroughly from our iniquities, and cleanse us from our sins. For we know our transgressions, and our sin is ever before us. Against You, You alone, have we sinned, and done what is evil in Your sight, so that You are justified in Your sentence and blameless when You pass judgment. Indeed, we were born guilty, sinners when our mothers conceived us. Hide Your face from our sins, and blot out all our iniquities. Create in us clean hearts, O God, and put new and right spirits within us. Do not cast us away from Your presence, and do not take Your Holy Spirit from us, we pray through Him Who loved us and gave Himself for us, even our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen. [Based upon Psa. 51]

Assurance of Pardon **Romans 8:33-34**

“Who will bring a charge against God’s elect? God is the one who justifies; who is the one who condemns? Christ Jesus is He who died, yes, rather who was raised, who is at the right hand of God, who also intercedes for us.”

Confession of Faith

I believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of Heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, His only begotten Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; He descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. From there He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic* church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.
