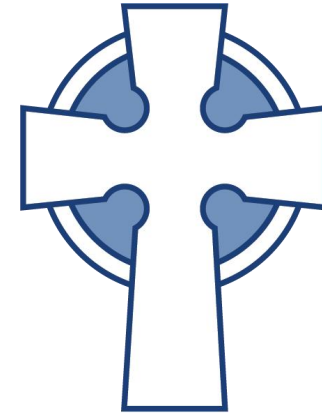

Preparation for Worship

Use the Call to Worship passage on the inside of the Order of Worship

Key points from the passage:

- o **Personal Commitment to Praise:** The psalmist resolves to exalt God as King and bless His name continuously.
- o **Worship is Daily and Lifelong:** Praise is not occasional, but daily and enduring - 'forever and ever'..
- o **God's Unsearchable Greatness:** The LORD is truly great, beyond our full understanding, and therefore worthy of endless praise.

Suggestions for Prayer

- o **Steadfast Praise:** Pray that He would give us hearts committed to bless and exalt Him, not just today, but always.
- o **Consistency in Worship:** Ask the Holy Spirit to fill us that we would be a people who praise Him daily, not only during this time of gathered worship.
- o **Awe at His Greatness:** Pray that we would have a deeper sense of wonder at His greatness, that our praise would be sincere and full.

Prelude: Use this time and the meditation on the back to quietly and prayerfully prepare yourself for worship

GOD CALLS US TO ENTER THE PRESENCE OF CHRIST

Call to Worship Psalm 145:1-3

Officiant: *I will extol You, my God, O King, and I will bless Your name forever and ever.*

Congregation: Every day I will bless You, and I will praise Your name forever and ever.

Officiant: *Great is the LORD, and highly to be praised,*

Congregation: And His greatness is unsearchable.

Confession of Sin

Congregation: O Father, we are gathered before You, the Maker of Heaven and Earth, Whose chosen dwelling place is with the broken and contrite, to confess that we have sinned in thought and word and deed; we have not loved You with all our heart and soul; we have not loved You with all our mind and strength; we have not even loved our neighbor as ourselves. Purge us from selfishness, the fear of man, and the love of praise. In Your mercy, deepen our sorrow for the wrong we have done and for the good we have left undone, so that we may hate our sin with a holy hatred. But, please Father, do not leave us in sorrow. With You, O Lord, there is forgiveness. In Your mercy, restore the joy of our salvation; so that we may love You with a holy love. Amen

Confession of Faith

I believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of Heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, His only begotten Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, and born of the Virgin Mary.
