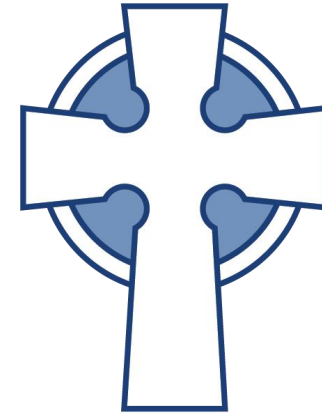

### Preparation for Worship

As we go through our liturgy, think about it not merely as a liturgy for worship, but also as an overview of the Christian life

- o **God Calls us to Worship:** We have been called out of darkness into His light so that we may proclaim His excellencies (1 Pt 2:9)
- o **Confession of Sin:** Coming to Jesus involves us confessing our sins to Him and calling out to Him to cleanse us from our unrighteousness (1 Jn 1:9)
- o **Assurance of Pardon:** We trust in Jesus as our Advocate before the Father and for being the propitiation for our sin (1 Jn 2:1-2) and we trust Him that all of our sins were forgiven by the work of Jesus on the cross (Col 2:11-13)
- o **Confession of Faith:** It's essential that we grow in grace and knowledge of Him Who saved us; that we believe the right things about Him. (1 John 4:1-2)
- o **Baptism:** Our baptism is a picture that we are clothed with Christ (Gal 3:27) and the gift of the Holy Spirit (Ez 36:25-27)
- o **Reading His Word:** We should spend time regularly in His Word, hiding it in our heart that we not sin against Him. (Ps 119:9-11).
- o **Preaching of the Word:** God uses the preached of the word to reprove, rebuke, and to exhort us in our Christian walk (1 Tim 4:1-3)
- o **The Lord's Supper:** When we partake of the Supper, we are sharing in the body and blood of Jesus
- o **Benediction:** We are sent into the world to serve Him and make disciples (Mt 26:16-20)

## GOD CLEANSSES US WITH THE BLOOD OF CHRIST

**Confession of Sin**

**Congregation:** Most holy and merciful Father, we acknowledge and confess before You our sinful nature, prone to evil and slothful in good, and all our shortcomings and offenses. You alone know how often we have sinned: in wandering from Your ways; in wasting Your gifts; in forgetting Your love. O Lord, have mercy upon us, we who are ashamed and sorry for everything in which we have displeased You. Teach us to hate our sins. Cleanse us from our secret faults. Forgive our sins, for the sake of Your dear Son. And O most holy and loving Father, help us, we beseech You, to live in Your light and walk in Your ways, according to the commandments of Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen. [Based upon The Book of Common Worship, first order]

*[Next shall follow a time of personal, private confession of sin]*
