## Preparation for Worship

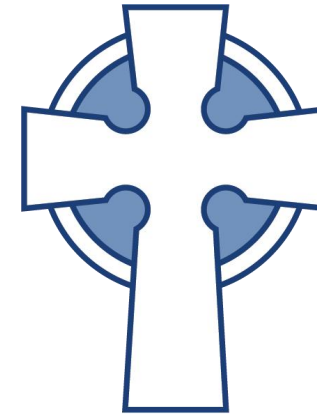
**"Ascribe to the LORD, O sons of the mighty, ascribe to the LORD glory and strength. Ascribe to the LORD the glory due to His name; Worship the LORD in holy array." Psalm 145:10**

### Key Points from the Passage:

- **God alone is worthy of glory:** We are called to recognize and declare the glory and strength that belong to the LORD alone
- **Worship is giving God what He is due:** Worship is not primarily about what we receive, but about honoring God according to His worth
- **We are called to worship with reverence:** The LORD is holy, and His people are to approach Him with awe, humility, and devotion

### Suggestions for Prayer:

- **Exalting God's glory:** Pray that our eyes would turn from ourselves and instead be fixed on His majesty, power, and greatness
- **Worship worthy of His name:** Ask the Spirit to help us offer praise and honor that are due to the Lord's holy name
- **Reverent hearts:** Pray that we would be prepared to worship Him with humility, purity, and holy reverence before His presence
