"For from Him and through Him and to Him are all things. To Him be the glory forever. Amen."

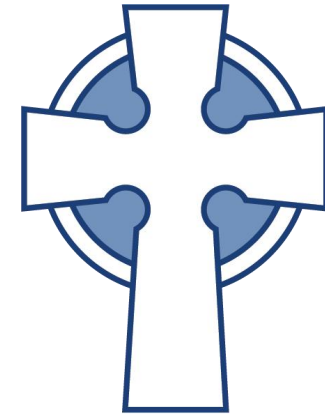
Romans 11:36.

Key Points from the Passage:

- o **God Is the Source of All Things** — Everything that exists comes from Him; our lives, salvation, and every blessing originate in His gracious hand
- o **God Sustains All Things** — All things continue through His power, wisdom, and providential care
- o **God Is the Goal of All Things** — Everything ultimately exists for His glory, and worship is our joyful acknowledgment of that truth

Suggestions for Prayer:

- o **Humility Before God:** Ask the Lord to remind us that all we have and all we are come from Him alone
- o **Trust in His Providence:** Pray for the Spirit to help us rest in the Lord's wise and sovereign care, knowing that all things are sustained through Him
- o **A God-Centered Worship:** Ask the Lord to turn our hearts from ourselves and fix them on His glory, that our worship would honor Him as the beginning, means, and end of all things

Congregation: **In whose hand are the depths of the earth, the peaks of the mountains are His also.**

Confession of Sin

Congregation: **Eternal God, in Whom we live and move and have our being, whose face is hidden from us by our sins, and whose mercy we forget in the blindness of our hearts; cleanse us from all our offenses, and deliver us from proud thoughts and vain desires, that with reverent and humble hearts we may draw near to You, confessing our sins, confiding in Your grace, and finding in You our refuge and strength; through Jesus Christ your Son, in whose name we pray, Amen.**

Confession of Faith

I believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of Heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, His only begotten Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; He descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. From there He will come to judge the living and the dead.
