Preparation for Worship

WLC 170: How do those who worthily participate in the Lord's Supper feed on the body and blood of Christ in it?

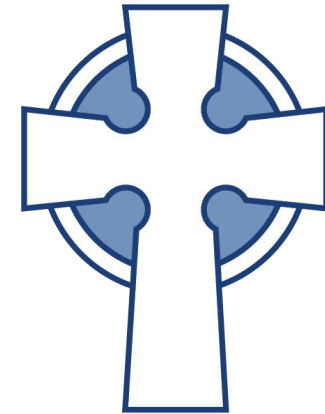
The body and blood of Christ are not bodily or physically present in, with, or under the bread and wine in the Lord's supper, and yet are spiritually present to the faith of the receiver, no less truly and really than the elements themselves are to their outward senses. Therefore those who worthily participate in the sacrament of the Lord's Supper feed on the body and blood of Christ in it, not in a bodily or physical manner but in a spiritual manner, but nevertheless truly and really, while by faith they receive and apply to themselves Christ crucified and all the benefits of his death.

Key Points from the Catechism:

- o **Christ is Truly Present by Faith** — Though Christ is not physically present in the bread and wine, He is truly and really present to believers through the Holy Spirit, and is received by faith.
- o **Believers Truly Feed on Christ and His Benefits** - In the Supper, believers spiritually partake of Christ crucified, receiving nourishment for their souls and all the benefits secured by His death.

Suggestions for Prayer:

- o **Faith to Receive Christ** - Ask the Lord to strengthen our faith that we may truly commune with Christ and receive Him as He is offered to us in this sacrament.
- o **Spiritual Nourishment and Assurance** - Ask the Spirit to feed and refresh our souls through Christ, assuring us anew of the grace and blessings purchased by His death.
