Key Points from the Passage

- God is gracious and will bless His people: God directing His face towards His people blesses them.
- He blesses to make Himself known.: God blesses His people not just to bless them, but in order to proclaim is salvation.
- The response to blessing is praise: God blesses not to receive praise, He should receive praise because He blesses. All people should praise Him.

Suggestions for Prayer:

- Consider His Blessings: Thank God for how He has blessed you and others. Thank Him for turning His face toward you.
- Blessed to be a Blessing: Ask the Holy Spirit to give opportunity to share with others how the Lord has blessed you. Especially to those who may not know Him.
- Praise the Lord!: Ask the Holy Spirit to help your heart truly praise His name this Lord's Day.
