Preparation for Worship

“Ascribe to the LORD the glory due His name; bring an offering, and come before Him, worship the LORD in holy array.” 1 Chronicles 16:29

Key Points from the Passage

- Give God the glory due His name:** God is worthy of our highest praise because of who He is and all He has done
- Come before Him with humble devotion:** Our worship is a response of gratitude, offering ourselves to God rather than coming merely as spectators
- Worship in holiness:** We approach a holy God with reverence, made acceptable through Christ and clothed in His righteousness

Suggestions for Prayer:

- Worshipful heart:** Pray for a heart that desires to give Him the glory due His name
- Thankful offering:** Ask the Holy Spirit to help us to offer ourselves to God in thankful and wholehearted worship
- Joy and reverence:** Prepare us to worship Him with reverence, holiness, and confidence in Christ
